#### Author Visits

At 9.50am a bell will ring to signify the end of the classroom open event.









































## **POWERFUL LEARNERS**

## P1D Maths

P1D have been using pattern sequencing games to create linear pattens. Students were very engaged in their learning.






## H1B Maths

H1B are looking at location and position in maths. We read Rosie's Walk and made hens out of playdough and feathers. The students then took Rosie for a walk on the map they had illustrated. We brainstormed words which described movement and direction such as across, over, under, left, right and sideways.

## P2AB Maths

P2AB students are learning to tell the time. We found out that an analog clock is really a number line in a circle. We are learning o'clock, quarter past, half past, quarter to.





## P2D Science

P2D are exploring SOUND in science. The students asked some questions they have about sound and will be investigating the answers this term. Their sound wall is looking very impressive.
