







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# **Student Achievement**

## **Keithcot Farm Primary School is an Allergy Aware School.**

#### This means that:

- Teachers will notify families in their class when there are food allergies present among their students, so they can avoid sending food that contains that ingredient.
- Students are monitored by staff during lunch eating time.
- Students are not allowed to share food, regardless of whether there are food allergies in their class or not.
- Staff are trained in anaphylactic response as part of their regular first aid courses.
- Students are encouraged to wash their hands after they finish eating.
- Teachers educate their classes about allergies and allergy—aware practices.
- Parents should keep the school informed of student allergies and ensure plans, EpiPens and medication are all up to date.

## **Attendance Procedures**

As per Department regulations, teachers are required to enter a code or reason each time a child is absent or late. We therefore ask parents to send a message via Class Dojo to the class teacher or to contact the front office before 8:30am. If you require your child(ren) to have an extended time away for any reason, an exemption application form can be completed. This is available from the front office.



The school day begins at 8:55am. Students benefit greatly from being part of the morning routine and should be present from this time. A yard duty teacher is on duty from 8:35am. If your child arrives late (after 8:55am) please ensure they are signed in via the Front Office so roll codes can be recorded. Families who need to collect their child(ren) earlier than 3:05pm are asked to sign them out at the Front Office before collecting them from the classroom.



## **Qkr App**

Please download the QKr app on your mobile telephone or smart device. This app will allow parents to pay school fees, excursions / incursions and even school lunches from the Rory's canteen (The menu is available on the app). Please see the front office if you require further information.

#### **Communication strengthens students learning**

This year all classes will continue to use Class Dojo to communicate with parents and families. New parents to our school should have received instructions of how to download the Class Dojo app onto a mobile or computer device. Teachers will use this platform to share and communicate with parents throughout the year. Parents are encouraged to use Class Dojo to communicate with their class teacher. We ask that teachers be given 24 working hours to respond to parents' questions. If you require an answer sooner, please contact the front office.




# **Acquaintance Night**


